Ronald (Ron) John Brown, passed away on June 24th, 2018, at the age of 83 years, after battling Parkinson's disease. As avid Beaver fans, Ron and Vi attended all kinds of OSU sporting events, and were season ticket holders for over 50 years. Ron ran the clock for OSU Wrestling for many years, and especially enjoyed annual get togethers with the Intergalactic Order of the Cosmos Alumni Wrestlers. Ron was also a member of the Corvallis Community Choir, a skilled woodturner, an athlete on several sports teams, and a perpetual tinkerer, collector, and curious mind. He taught himself many skills, and was happy to share his knowledge and experience with others.

Ron was always one to lend a helping hand to his neighbors, family, and friends. He was a loving father and grandfather, and he touched everyone around him with his sense of

humor, his easy-going attitude, and his generosity. He will be forever missed.
