Spencer Patrick Bauer, aged 22, was taken suddenly on Sunday, May 22nd.

Spencer was born on October 2nd, 1993 in Corvallis to Gary Bauer and Lisa Mount (Lambert). He was a clear blue eyed little brother in a house full with three sisters. Spencer was a most wanted and prayed for addition. As Spencer grew he proved to be an adventurous and spirited little boy who when little loved the color red. He became a big brother to Zachary in 1998. They began their lives together as the best of buds.

As a teenager Spencer would demonstrate the ability to master anything he put his mind and effort into. This was the case academically and physically with Spencer showing particular natural skill on the wrestling mat. Spencer elected to leave high school prior to graduating, but in 2013 without preparation walked in and successfully earned his GED on the first go. He was immensely proud of this as were we all.

In 2012 Spencer welcomed his son Zayden. There was never a more proud father and Spencer spent that first year showing his ability to be an amazing care giver to his son. He continued to love Zayden fiercely. Over the past year Spencer exhibited a great deal of growth personally and professionally.
