Andrew "Andy" Lyle Gellatly, 85 of Corvallis passed away peacefully Tuesday at Corvallis Manor. Born May 26, 1925 in Philomath, he was the youngest of four children born to Robert Holmes and Christina Jacobina Gellatly. Andy's grandparents settled in Philomath in 1870, where his parents were born and raised. Andy also grew up and spent most of his life in Philomath. He graduated from Philomath High School.
