Annetta 'Nettie' Lindskog, 96 died November 19th at Park Place Assisted Living in Corvallis. Nettie was born March 18, 1919 in DeSmet, South Dakota to parents Erwin and Bertha Gehm Macheel. She graduated from high school and married Henning J. 'Slim' Christensen in 1940 and he passed away in 1977. Nettie worked as a bookkeeper for Open Door. In the last few weeks I have been clearing out more of the mountain of paper at my house. I came across a memorial service bulletin and newspaper obit that my Mom, in her customary fashion, had sent to me in 2007....a Memorial/funeral bulletin and newspaper obituary for Don Lindskog, our neighbor Nettie's second husband. This got me searching and I found, on this website, an obituary for dear neighbor Nettie.

I just had to follow up on this via various groups. Could not find any relatives that were closely related to Nettie that I could contact...but hope this may reach you in some fashion. Several nieces were mentioned by first name only as ones who made intermittent visits to Corvallis to see Nettie. So, I contacted Zion Lutheran Church, her church, for possible memorial. Fund sent to them are going to the Quilter's Group...fabulous!

I grew up across the street from Nettie and 'Slim' Christensen from 1950 to 1967. Pursued my career in Portland. Every time that I visited my parents in Corvallis, I walked across 31st Street to at least say "Hi, how ya' doing?" to Nettie. She was my "Corvallis Aunt".

My parents and Nettie, with Slim Christensen or with Donald Lindskog. were neighbors from about 1950 to 2005. (my parents moved to assisted living in 2005).

Nettie was such a wonderfully sweet lady! And she "beat my Mom on longevity...Mom died at age 94 1/2; Netie made it to 96! Bravo!

I'll always remember the gorgeous camellia bushes on either side of her home's doorway.

I feel blessed to have known this wonderful woman!
