Calvin was born in Harlan, Oregon, to Clifford and Jessie McDonald. When Calvin was about 6 years of age, we the family moved to Prineville, OR. He spent many years of his youth riding his horse through the hills in central Oregon and helping on the family farm. (As a young boy he once rode his horse into the Prineville school building, and was reprimanded accordingly).



In high school he placed first in state for the high jump and competed in local rodeo competitions.

Calvin had many interests, among them were scuba diving, hydroplane racing, beekeeping, leather work, animal husbandry, pigeon racing, horse training, hunting, fishing, gemology, and pretty much anything pertaining to the outdoors.

Calvin served as a police officer for almost 30 years for the Corvallis Police Department and reached the rank of Lieutenant before retiring in 1986.

Calvin is survived by his wife of 57 years, Irene, children Karen, Janice, and Calvin Jr., grandchildren Jerry, Chris, Harlan and Heath and three great-granddaughters. He is also survived by his youngest brother, Clinton.

He was much beloved and will be greatly missed.
