A memorial service for Cecil Curtis Hockema, who died Tuesday, June 3, in Philomath, will be held at 1:30 p.m. Saturday, June 14, at Alsea Baptist Church.

Born Dec. 5, 1921, in Gravel Ford, the son of T.D. and Annie Hockema, Cecil grew up in the Alsea Valley.

During World War II, he served in the U.S. Army in Europe.

He was married April 17, 1943, in Aiken, S.C., to the former Jean Perkins.

She preceded him in death in April 2007, following 64 years of marriage.

He worked in logging and construction and drove trucks for Arco until his retirement.
