



## Cecil Scott

July 25, 1928 - October 15, 2007

Cecil Stanley Scott died peacefully at home in Albany on Monday. He was 79. Born in Monmouth to Burton and Orel Scott on July 25, 1928, Cecil grew up in Oregon and then joined the US Army at the beginning of the Korean conflict. He served in Korea, assigned to Custer's old outfit, the 7th Cavalry Regiment. After the war, Cecil returned to Oregon and on February 11, 1956, married Delcie Hargan in Eugene. In 1958 they moved to Corvallis where Cecil owned and operated Scott's Electric for 34 years retiring in 1992 at the age of 64. During his retirement Cecil and Delcie wintered in Southern California. They have resided in Albany since 1992.

Cecil was a proud member of the Corvallis VFW. He is survived by his wife, Delcie, of Albany; sons and daughters-in-law Curtis and Kelly Scott of Albany and Chris and Gayle Scott of Hesperia, Calif. and five grandchildren.

Graveside services will be at 11 am on Friday, Oct. 19 at Willamette Memorial Park in Albany.
