Charles Edwin Schwartz, 76, of Corvallis died Jan. 27 at the Samaritan Albany General Hospital.

He was born in Alliance, Nebraska, to Ivan and Evelyn Danskey Schwartz. At the age of 5, Charlie moved to Corvallis with his family. He called Corvallis "home" for the next 71 years.

Charlie started working at a young age alongside his father, Ivan Schwartz, at the family restaurant "The Steak House." In 1958, Charlie graduated from Corvallis High School. He married Beverly Hales, also from Corvallis, on June 13, 1964.

In the late 1960s Charlie became a letter carrier for the Corvallis Post Office. During his long career at the post office, Charlie accumulated many awards for exceptional service and safe driving. He was beloved by his coworkers and delivery route customers until his retirement in 2005.

Charlie enjoyed gardening vegetables and flowers. He was well known for his home-grown hot peppers. Charlie was also an accomplished charcoal sketch artist but he did not express his talent often. Charlie was kind, social, funny and devoted to God.

He will be missed by all those fortunate enough to know and love him.

He is survived by his daughters, Kristel Jordan and Dori Laboune, and grandson Seth Jordan.

He was preceded in death by his wife.

A funeral service will be at 11 a.m. Friday, Feb. 10, at Calvary Chapel Corvallis.
