



Clark Richard Amen

August 17, 1919 - March 23, 2013

Clark was born on Aug. 17, 1919, in Walla Walla, Wash., to Catherine and John Amen.

He grew up in the Walla Walla area. He was a navigator in the U.S. Army Air Corps during World War II. His plane was shot down in 1944, and he spent the rest of the war as a prisoner of war.

He married Marjorie Cochran on Dec. 9, 1942. Following the war, they moved to Corvallis, where Clark graduated from Oregon State College with a degree in entomology. He worked for American Cyanamid Company for more than 30 years.

Clark was preceded in death by his wife, Marjorie; his parents; and his brother, Frank Amen. He is survived by daughters Susan Hammond, Cathy Mattatall and Nancy Fischer; six grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.
