



Clayton Tabor

November 27, 1941 - October 10, 2007

Clayton H. Tabor died Wednesday. He was 64.

Born in Corvallis on Nov. 27, 1941 to Harry and Mildred Tabor, Clayton grew up in Corvallis and attended local schools here. He served in the U.S. Army from May of 1967 until May of 1969. He served one tour in Vietnam. He also served in the Oregon National Guard in the 1980s and 90s.

In 1963 he married Judy Jacob and they had one child, James Craig Tabor. They later divorced.

Clayton worked as a heavy equipment operator for the City of Corvallis and later as a choker setter in the logging business.

He had a long career as a boxer with the Albany Boxing Club, winning a Golden Glove and many trophies. He was a member of the Corvette Club and the American Legion.

He was preceded in death by his parents and is survived by his son, Craig of Hawaii; sisters Myrna Clark of Madras and Kathy Marta of Wauconda, Wash.; nieces Stacey Hardin of Monroe, Ashley Clark of Corvallis, Crystal Moore of Enumclaw, Wash., and Roberta Marta of Puyallup, Wash.; and nephew Mitch Marta of Wauconda, Wash.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 16, at McHenry Funeral Home. Burial with military honors will follow at Oak Lawn Memorial Park in Corvallis.
