March 5, 1936 - June 16, 2007

Clive A. (Scott) Chisholm, died June 16, 2007 of complications due to stroke. Born March 5, 1936 in Warton, Ontario, Canada to Laura Alderson and Herman "Duff" Chisholm. In 1954 he left Canada for the United States. Following studies at Graceland College (now University) in Iowa and the University of Missouri, he embarked on a 45-year career as English and Journalism professor, poet and writer. He taught in universities and colleges across America, including State University of New York from 1971 to 1986, and Utah State University (as a Department Head) from 1986 until retirement in 1999. Scott published the award-winning book "Following The Wrong God Home" in 2003. He was ordained a Catholic Deacon in 2004. In 2005 he moved to Corvallis, Oregon to be near family. Preceded in death by son Sean Mitchell Chisholm and granddaughter Amelia Garrison. He is survived by wife Linda Anderson Chisholm, son Christopher Budd (Thomas), daughter Laura Caitlin Chisholm (Patrick), grandchildren Finn and Ry Garrison, and sister, Canadian artist Laura Carter.
