



## Coral Torley

August 6, 1920 - July 9, 2011

Coral C. Torley of Corvallis died Saturday, July 9, 2011, at Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center in Corvallis. She was 90 years old.

Coral's two sons, James Torley (Kathryn) of Colorado Springs, Colo., and Lawrence Torley (Victoria) of Fayetteville, Ga., were with her at the time of her death. She is also survived by four grandsons.

Coral and her husband, Robert (Bob) E. Torley (now deceased), moved to Corvallis in 1972 from Wilton, Conn. Coral and Bob were members of First Congregational United Church of Christ in Corvallis. Both Coral and Bob were active members of the church, the Isaac Walton League, the Corvallis Men's Garden Club and other civic organizations.
