Dale Woolston LaRue, 88, of Lebanon died Friday, June 1, in Lebanon. He was born in Wakeeny, Kan., to Mary Dazey LaRue and William LaRue. He married the love of his life, Edna, on Jan. 29, 1945, in Lebanon. He earned a bachelor's degree in religious education from Puget Sound College of the Bible, and a master's degree in religious education from Emmanuel School of Religion.
