Dallas Earl Pizer, 86 of Philomath died Thursday at Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center in Corvallis. Born 2/1/1922; he was the son of Earl Dallas and Estella (Bennett) Pizer. Dallas' early school years were spent at Tidewater Logging Camp near Astoria. He graduated from Jewell High School in rural Astoria. He served in the US Navy from 1942 – 1945 aboard the USS Vestal in the South Pacific. On July 23, 1946, Dallas and Levis Koplien were married in Corvallis. They had two daughters, Linda and Sheila. He was recalled to serve during the Korean Conflict. He was stationed on the USS Lewis E. Hancock from 1951 until his discharge in 1952.

Dallas spent most of his career as a truck driver. He enjoyed fishing, hunting, camping, steam engines, being with friends and working on the family home in his free time. He will be remembered as a loving husband, father and grandfather. He was a lifetime member of the Corvallis Elks, VFW in Corvallis, the American Legion, Teamsters Union #162, the US Navy Memorial and the Hancock Reunion.

Preceded in death by his parents; two brothers Donald and Ralph and one sister Dorothy; Dallas is survived by his wife of nearly 62 years, Levis; his daughters and their spouses Linda and Randy Meredith of Lancaster, California and Sheila and John Marshall of Hillsboro and one granddaughter Leanne Marshall.

A Memorial Service will be held at 11:00 am Tuesday, April 22nd at McHenry Funeral Home. A luncheon reception will follow the service. The family
