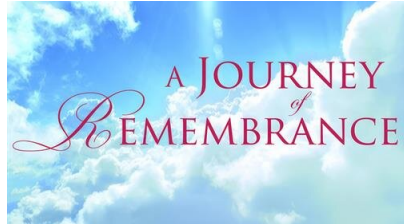
numerous great grandchildren.
