



Eleanor Kirkpatrick

July 21, 1916 - February 13, 2013

Former Corvallis resident Eleanor L. McCulley Kirkpatrick died in Beaverton at the age of 96.

She grew up on a wheat ranch in the Pendleton area. She married F. Donald Kirkpatrick of Pendleton in 1940. They moved to Corvallis in 1947, where Eleanor resided until moving to Hearthstone at Murrayhill in Beaverton in 2001. While living in Corvallis, she became known for raising abandoned fawn deer for 29 years in conjunction with her husband's work for the Oregon Fish and Wildlife Commission.

She was preceded in death by her husband in 1979. She is survived by two daughters, Kathleen Bodyfelt (Richard) of Tigard and Mary Ann Kirkpatrick of Seattle; two grandsons, Kirk Bodyfelt (Melynda) and Scott Bodyfelt, DMD (Miranda); and two great-grandchildren, twins Zachary and Lauren Bodyfelt.
