Emily W. Good of Corvallis died on Oct. 2, 2010, her 84th birthday, after a long and happy life.

She was born to Kathleen and Howard Jones in 1926 in Huntsville, Ala. She earned a bachelor degree at the University of Alabama and a master's degree at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, where she met William B. Good, who became her beloved husband.

Mrs. Good spent most of her adult life in Las Cruces, N.M., raising a family with her husband, and working as an applied mathematician at New Mexico State University and White Sands Missile Range.

Later in life she was nationally distinguished for her work as a miniaturist, and a permanent collection of her art is now housed at the Toy and Miniature Museum in Kansas City, Mo.

Mrs. Good was preceded in death by her parents; her sister Edith Ledbetter; her brother Harvie Jones; and her husband. Survivors include her brother Howard Jones Jr. of New Market, Ala.; her daughter and son-in-law Amy and Steven Kunert of Corvallis; her daughter Leslie Good of Portland; and numerous nieces and nephews.

Interment will take place at Maple Hill Cemetery in Huntsville.
