Gloria A. Scoville of Corvallis passed away peacefully at home on Friday evening, April 15. She was 80 years old.

Gloria was born Jan. 19, 1931, in Vernonia, the youngest of three children of M. Fred Wall Sr. and Corinne Wall. She lived most of her youth in Toledo, and graduated from Toledo High School in 1949.

Gloria married Jack Scoville on July 16, 1950, and they lived in Redmond for the first year of their marriage, moving to Corvallis in 1951. While in Corvallis, Gloria worked for Day's Market and the Benton County Sheriff's Office.

In September 1963, Gloria and Jack opened their Corvallis auto dealership, Scoville-Sheppard, Ltd., which later became Jack Scoville, Ltd. Gloria was an active partner in the dealership, serving as secretary/treasurer, and she remained involved in the business until recently.

Gloria cherished time with her family and friends, and enjoyed camping and spending weekends supporting the longtime sports car-racing careers of her husband and son, Jeff.

Gloria will be greatly missed by Jack, her husband of 60 years; son, Jeff of Corvallis; daughter, Lisa and her husband, Kraig Luther of Corvallis; brother and sister-in-law, Fred and Linda Wall of Woodland, Wash.; and her beloved pets Maggie and Mia.

Gloria was preceded in death by her father, M. Fred Wall Sr.; mother, Corinne Wall; and brother, Robert Wall.
