



## Henry Warner Nystrom

September 4, 1926 - April 25, 2018

Henry W. Nystrom formerly of Corvallis passed away April 25 at the Cascade Inn Assisted Living in Vancouver, Washington. He was 91.

Henry, known affectionately as "Hank," was born in Los Angeles, California, on September 4, 1926. He was raised in Los Angeles and served in the US Navy through the end of World War II.

He later married Patsy L. Miles in 1963. They began their married life in Redwood City, California. In 1969, the family moved to Corvallis and here he retired from the student housing center on the Oregon State University campus in 1992. He was a long time member of the Zion Lutheran Church, and for the past 12 years has lived in Vancouver to be near his children and grandchildren.
