Accounting was a true passion of Ilene's and she put her heart and soul into her business. She was a genius with numbers (and understanding tax laws). She always went above and beyond to help clients; whether it was helping a client start their dream business or acting as conservator/trustee/payee for a person in need. Throughout her life Ilene was dedicated to serving her community, she worked closely with many local non-profits and served on the boards of multiple local organizations (including CIBA & PEERS). In addition to serving her community Ilene was devoted to serving God, she acted as church treasurer for her church for many years and almost never missed attending church on Sunday (even during tax season). Ilene had a deep love for reading, baking, and her family. Ilene was truly a soul that made this world a better place and she will be deeply missed by many.

Ilene was preceded in death by her parents and the love of her life Clifford Taylor Anderton. Her legacy will live on through her children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
