James Henry Johnson, 92, died Sunday in Corvallis. He was born April 8, 1918, to Robert A. and Beryl Johnson in Saline, Missouri. He married Cornelia “Connie” Bond on December 13, 1941. He served as a 2nd lieutenant in the U. S. Army during World War II. Jim was a long-time employee of Fisher Implement. His interests included farming, hunting, and fishing. He was an avid weaver and actually used his grandmother’s antique loom to produce weavings that he shared with family and friends. He enjoyed bowling at Highland Bowl for over 25 years, until he was 89 ½. He was a member of First Christian Church of Corvallis for 50 years. Jim was a quiet, gentle man, respected by all who knew him—his handshake was his word. After the death of his beloved Connie, Jim married Mary Zeiger who also preceded him in death. His son, James died in 2009. Jim is survived by his daughter and son-in-law, Jane and Mike Williams of Aurora; grandson Matthew Williams and grand daughter Melanie Mock; great grandsons Brandon and Logan Mock; brother Thornton Johnson of Eugene, and numerous step-children and step-grandchildren.
