



## Jay McClaghry

March 25, 1930 - April 5, 2012

Jay McClaghry of Brownsville died Thursday, April 5, of age-related causes. He was 82.

He was born March 25, 1930, in Alpine to William Thomas and Helen McClaghry. He married Hazel Marteney on June 3, 1949.

He graduated from Monroe Union High School in 1948, and later attended Linn-Benton Community College. He was a truck driver and a skilled equipment operator, and owned a logging truck company. He was director of the Alpine Cemetery Association. He was a volunteer firefighter and later a member of the Monroe Fire Protection District Board of Directors.

Survivors include his wife of 62 years, Hazel; a daughter, Chris Moody of Junction City; a son, Doug McClaghry of Brownsville; six grandchildren; 15 great-grandchildren; and four great-great-grandchildren. Infant daughter Laura Jean died previously.
