Jeanette Mildred Truog, resident of Corvallis; Parachute, Colo.; and Woodland Hills, Calif., died peacefully Tuesday morning, with Peter David Truog, her loving husband of 60 years, at her side.

Jeanette was born May 15, 1931, in Erie, Pa., the daughter of Lewis John Buskist and Jennie Paschen Buskist, and is survived by her sister, Elizabeth Spicer. She graduated from South High School in Youngstown, Ohio.

In 1975, Dave and Jeanette founded the Truog-Ryding Company, a pension administration firm in Southern California. Diagnosed with breast cancer in 1982, Jeanette beat the odds of a poor prognosis, which allowed her to share many rewarding years with her friends and family. At approximately age 60, she began to play golf, and enjoyed many happy times on the golf course with her husband, Dave. Other passions included ice skating, playing the piano, cooking, traveling and reading.

Jeanette leaves her two children, Cyndee Jean Wright of Lebanon, and Robert David Truog, M.D., of Cambridge, Mass. She is also survived by her five grandchildren, who brought her more joy than words can say.

As a lifetime member of the Lutheran Church, Jeanette's deep faith in God brought her strength and comfort throughout her life. "Be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life."
