March 27, 1960 - March 27, 2008

Jeanne C. Hazleton died at home Thursday, on her 48th birthday, following a three-year battle with breast cancer.

Jeanne was born on March 27, 1960, in Billings, Mont., to Lloyd and Frances (Burriss) Lund. She soon moved to Anchorage, Alaska, where she survived the great Alaskan Earthquake on her fourth birthday in 1964. In 1975, the family moved to Medford and in 1978 she graduated from Medford High School.

From 1978 through 1980 she attended Oregon State University. On Aug. 9, 1981, she married Patrick Hazleton. She worked for more than 20 years as a licensed massage therapist and a certified doula. She assisted in more than 200 home and hospital births.

She was a member of the Suburban Christian Church.

Jeanne is survived by her husband, Pat, of Corvallis; children Nicole and husband Christopher Zimmerman, and Valerie, Daniel, Sarah and Robert, all of Corvallis; brothers Christopher of Portland and Lloyd of Waco, Texas; and step-mother Kay Philips-Lund of Medford.

A memorial service will be at 1 p.m. Tuesday at the Suburban Christian Church in Corvallis.
