



## Jeanne Marie Oar Anderson Ballantyne

April 26, 1919 - August 5, 2016

Jeanne Marie (Liden) Oar Anderson Ballantyne, 97, of Corvallis, Oregon, passed away peacefully on Friday, August 5, 2016. The youngest of 13 children born to Charles and Anna Liden, she was born in Thief River Falls, Minnesota on April 26, 1919 moments after her twin sister, Elma.

In 1940 Jeanne married Alwin David Oar in Los Angeles. In 1952 Al was killed in the Korean Conflict and Jeanne moved to Oregon with her children.

In 1962 Jeanne married Retired Army Captain Glen Raymond Anderson.

During their marriage

of 38 years they lived in Eugene, Elmira, Brookings, Port Ludlow and finally settled in Omak,

Washington to be near their daughter Bonnie. Glen died in 1999.

Jeanne married Orrel Ballantyne on her 90th birthday. They lived in Klamath Falls for a few

years and then for health reasons they relocated to assisted living in Salem. In 2014 Jeanne and

Orrel moved to Stoneybrook Assisted Living in Corvallis to be near their son Ken.

Jeanne is survived by her husband, Orrel, two sons, David Oar of Centennial, Colorado, and

Kenneth Oar of Corvallis, Oregon; along with two daughters, Katheryn Anderson of Spokane,

Washington and Bonnie Little of Omak, Washington; 15 grandchildren, 42

great-grandchildren

and 5 great-great-grandchildren. Preceding her in death in December 1992 was her eldest

child, Cherris LeJeanne Snow.

Private family services will be held. She will be interred with her late husband, Lt Alwin David Oar, at Willamette National Cemetery in Portland, Oregon.
