



## John Ashton Fuller

December 20, 1919 - August 14, 2011

Jack Fuller of Corvallis died Sunday, Aug. 14, at home. He was 91.

He was born in Wheaton, Minn., to John and Geno Hayes Fuller. He spent his childhood in Nebraska and Colorado, and moved to Oregon at age 18. He served in World War II after joining the U.S. Army in 1941. Upon returning to Oregon, he married Caroline Oliver in 1946. Together they had three boys. He worked as the manager of the gas station located at the intersection of Third Street and Van Buren Avenue until he retired in 1986.

Survivors include his sons, George Fuller and Jerry Fuller; daughter-in-law, Karen Fuller; sisters, Faye Robinson and Lois Morehouse; five grandchildren; and 11 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife, Caroline; son, Gary; two brothers; and a granddaughter.
