Joshua Roland Nelson, 20, formerly of Corvallis, Ore., passed away after an accident at Liberty Lake, Wash., on Dec. 18, 2012. Josh was born Oct. 29, 1992, at Beale AFB, Calif., the second son of Jared and Elizabeth Nelson. He spent his early years in Nebraska and England, before the family moved to Corvallis in 2000. He attended Franklin School and graduated from Corvallis High School in 2011. While at CHS, he participated in cross country, swimming and pole vault. He earned his Eagle Scout Award in October 2008 and went on to earn five palms as a result of completing 48 merit badges. He was first in his age group in the Beaver Freezer Triathlon (mountain bike division) in 2010 and 2011. He went to Philmont Scout Ranch in 2011 with his troop and hiked over 400 miles in various national parks with his father. He was a sophomore at Brigham Young University, Provo, Utah, studying science and math. Josh had a wonderful sense of humor and many friends. He had a tender heart and was loved by his family. Josh is survived by his parents of Liberty Lake; brother, Brad of Hanover, NH; sister, Andrea of Corvallis; and brothers, Spencer and Michael, both of Liberty Lake. He is also survived by his grandparents, Charles and Jean Nelson, and David and Cherrie Blake, all of Corvallis; and numerous aunts, uncles and cousins. A viewing will be held at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, 4141 NW Harrison Blvd, Corvallis, on Saturday, Dec. 22, 2012, at 10 a.m., followed by a funeral service at 11 a.m. Burial will follow at Locke Cemetery.
