Judith Kay McClain, 66, died peacefully during the afternoon of April 25, 2011, at her home in Corvallis, with her husband by her side. Her passing came after a courageous five-year battle with ovarian cancer.

Judy was born June 13, 1944, in Albany to Robert and Kay Schmidt. She grew up on her parents' farm near Millersburg, and graduated from Albany High School. She married Dick McClain on Dec. 20, 1969, the day after finals at Oregon State University.

Her interests included her family, extended family, friends, flower gardening, tea parties, cooking and puzzles. She was a major Beaver Believer.

Judy was a devoted Christian, and her relationship with Jesus provided great comfort and strength, especially while fighting cancer. She was always available to family and friends. Above everything else, those who knew her always commented on the positive outlook she had on everything - in both good times and difficult times.

Judy is survived by her husband, Dick; her two sons, Brent and Steve, and their wives, Verda and Kate; her brothers, David Schmidt, Wayne Schmidt and John Schmidt, and their wives, Heidi, Sharon and Sandra; her sister, Joanne Gould, and her husband, Norm; and seven grandchildren, Cece, Kaylynn, Leah, Sarah, Rylee, Harper and Aislin.

She was preceded in death by her daughter, Cheryl McClain, in 1980; her father, Robert Schmidt, in 2006; and her mother, Kay Schmidt, in 2006.

A memorial service will take place at 2 p.m. Monday, May 2, at First Baptist

Church in Corvallis. Private family interment will take place in Crystal Lake Cemetery in Corvallis.
