I replied, ""There is a Ziplock bag in the glove compartment blow fast". My car was ten years old at that time I called it my little tonka toy. 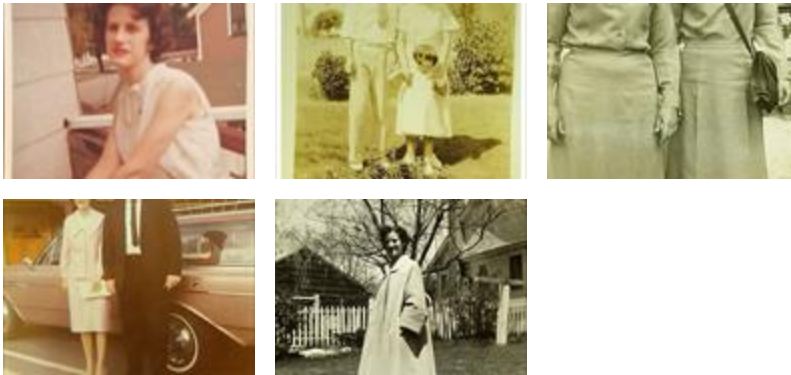
