



## June Gray

November 14, 1915 - July 21, 2009

June Hunter Gray passed away July 21, 2009, from complications of a fall she suffered on July 12.

Leola June Grant was born Nov. 14, 1915 to Lester and Althea Grant at Harlan, Oregon. She had seven brothers and sisters and was part of a large extended pioneer family.

June graduated from Harlan High school and later met and married L.S. "Bud" Hunter of Edgerton, Alberta Canada on Oct. 30, 1939. They resided in Harlan until 1964 where she drove school bus for 17 yrs. She was very involved in community activities, the Big Elk Grange and 4-H clubs. June and Bud moved to Philomath in 1964 and she went to work at Oregon State University as a laboratory assistant for the food toxicology research program on fish cancer. June worked there from 1964 until 1978. Bud died in 1979 and in 1981 she met and married Kenneth D. Gray of Philomath. She was active in the Mary's River Grange and the Winema Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution. Ken died in 1997. June moved to the Albany Alterra Retirement Home in 2000 and then to Salem in 2004.

June was preceded in death by her parents, six siblings, and both husbands. She is survived by her daughter Sandra Stein and son L.E. "Gene" Hunter, both of Salem, stepsons Richard Gray of Bend, Don Gray of Eugene, and Tom Gray of Philomath, numerous grandchildren and great grandchildren.
