



## Keiva Mae Rapraeger

August 3, 1923 - March 27, 2017

Keiva Mae Rapraeger, a long-time resident passed away on Monday, March 27, 2017. She was born on August 3, 1923 to Albert and Flossie Moncur in Ree Heights, South Dakota. At age 3 her family moved to Miller, South Dakota. Her mother passed away during her childhood so she and her two brothers were raised on their grandparents' farm. She graduated from Miller High School in 1942.

In 1943 she came to Oregon and began work as a telephone operator for Pacific Northwest Bell until she retired 28 years later. In 1952 she married the love of her life, Harold Rapraeger, in Smith River, California. He passed away in 1976.
