



Kuna Cha Woods

June 14, 1944 - February 24, 2016

Former Pulaski County, Missouri, resident Kun Cha Woods, age 72, died Wednesday, Feb. 24, 2016, at the University of Colorado Hospital in Denver, Colorado, with her family by her side.

Mrs. Woods was born June 14, 1944, in Jeollado, South Korea. She was a woman who was brave enough to cross an ocean and immigrate to a new country with her husband, Lorin Woods, a veteran whom she met in Korea while he was serving the United States Army.

Mrs. Woods was a kind, strong and an independent woman who could accomplish anything she set her mind to do. She worked many decades at Ford Leonard Wood Army and Air Force Base in Missouri as a cook serving thousands of the men and women in the military until she retired several years ago. She spent almost 50 years in Waynesville, Missouri, with her husband, Lorin Woods, who passed away in 1998. She will be buried next to his grave in Alsea Cemetery in Alsea.

She was the fourth child of six siblings and is survived by her brothers, Chong Ho Sin, Jung Jae Sin, Chung In Sin, older sister Choon Cha Choi and over 40 nieces, nephews and in-laws who reside in California, Colorado, Texas and Oregon.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Salshim Myung and Makdong Shin; husband Lorin Woods; youngest sister Choon Ye Song; and many of her beloved dogs which she loved as her own children during her lifetime.

Her interests included family gatherings, gardening, fishing, reading the Bible and caring for animals. She devoted much of her time and energy as an active church member and donated to small charities. She was loved by many of her neighbors, friends and family and will be truly missed.

A funeral service will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday, March 5, 2016, at McHenry Funeral Home, 206 N.W. Fifth St, Corvallis. The casket will be open one hour prior to the service.
