I met Lance back in 2011, going door to door, passing out invitations to Baptist in Philomath. I enjoyed visiting with him, and was pleased that I had breakfasts several times. From time to time I would see him around town.

On a very personal note, I was told that the summer following his graduation from El Dorado Hills, that the love of his life, Marlo Hannifan, was killed in an accident. Something died within him when he lost Marlo and he was never able to get back again. Lance also dearly loved his son Codie, but due to unfortunate circumstances, he has never been able to see Codie since he was 3 years old, even though he thought he would be on a regular basis. Over the years Lance has struggled with alcohol, drugs, and twice in prison. Through all that heartache, he always found solace in the Lord. Lance has read Proverbs and tried to read a chapter every day.

Lance served in the United States Marine Corp as a helicopter mechanic. After the war he worked in construction for many years throughout his life. He worked in accounting for a few years, and he also worked as a marine mechanic in Utah. Since moving to Oregon he has been pursuing a degree in engineering at Oregon State University.

Lance had the wonderful opportunity to travel extensively through London, Holland and Switzerland with a few of his buddies in 1998.

From our conversation last Saturday afternoon, the family assured me of the assurance of his personal salvation in Fresno, CA, in 2004.

In July of 2013, Lance was a part of the group from Grace City Church on a mission camp in Oaxaca, Mexico. One dream of his came true!
