Lee Roy Schreiber, 82 died Saturday at his home in Corvallis. Lee Roy was born on February 11, 1932 in Portland. He was the youngest of 9 children: Hank, Leo, Leah, Rachel, Esther, Johnny, Monte and George. Lee Roy graduated from Alsea High School. He married Lura Ellen Hendrix on September 16, 1951. The couple had four sons Mark, Bryon, Kurt and Kyle. Mr. Schreiber served in the U. S. Army during the Korean Conflict. He worked in the forest industry driving log truck for four decades. He liked to hunt and spend time on the coast crabbing. He will be remembered for his distinct sense of humor and his sometimes brutal honesty—you always knew where you stood with Lee Roy Schreiber.

Mr. Schreiber is preceded in death by his son Kurt, who died in 2004; his grandson Tyson, who died in 2012 and all of his siblings.
