



## Lenore Weisner

Lenore I. Weisner, 76, of Newport passed away Oct. 25, 2012, in Corvallis.

Lenore was born to Hal Henderson and Marjorie (Riddle) Henderson on Oct. 5, 1936, in Calgary, Alberta, Canada, the first of five children.

In 1949, the family moved to Albany, where Lenore met Stephen Cordell Weisner. They were married on July 2, 1955, in North Bonneville, Wash.

In the final three years of her life, Lenore moved into Oceanview Senior Living in Newport. She loved every minute of her time with her loving friends and the dedicated staff at Oceanview.
