



## Leola Campbell

January 13, 1923 - February 10, 2012

Born Leola Matilda Addelade Sackville to May Gertrude (Lester) and Harold Alva Sackville in Pike Lake, Saskatchewan, Canada, Leola emigrated to the United States through Eastport, Idaho, with her mother on Sept. 26, 1928. Together they lived in Cheney, Wash., La Grande and finally Medford, where Leola graduated from high school and met Leigh Edward Campbell, the love of her life. Leola and Leigh married Christmas Eve 1941, and enjoyed three weeks of marital bliss before Leigh entered the U.S. Army Air Force and was soon off to England and World War II.

Son Gary was born later that year, and was nearly 3 years old when Leigh returned to his new family after the war. Daughter Carol came along shortly thereafter, and daughter Lois joined the family a few years later.

The family resided in Medford until 1954, when Leigh's work took him briefly to Vancouver, Wash., and then to the Beaverton area, where they resided until 1968, when they relocated to Corvallis. Throughout those years, Leola was a devoted wife and mother, and enjoyed a very active outdoor lifestyle with her family.

Leola was preceded in death by Leigh Campbell, her husband of 30 years. She is survived by son and daughter-in-law Gary and Elizabeth Campbell of Corvallis; daughter and son-in-law Carol and Phillip Raab of Springfield; daughter Lois Engbretson of Lakewood, Colo.; seven grandchildren; and 12 great-grandchildren. Private services were held in Corvallis.
