Lester (Les) Samuel Moore passed away at his home in Corvallis on March 14, 2013 at the age of 77. Les is predeceased by his parents, Lester and Carrie Moore, and his sister, Evelyn Mathews. Les is survived by his loving wife Mary of 39 years. They were married in Santa Clara on April 14, 1973. Les was placed on stand by return to active duty status during the Cuban Missile Crisis.

Les started his career as a hardware engineer during the early days of the Silicon Valley. Employed by Hewlett Packard, Les worked for and directly under both Bill Hewlett and Dave Packard. Besides being a career long employee with Hewlett Packard, Les worked along side some of Silicon Valley's greatest success stories.

Les enjoyed his life long enthusiasm of Japanese landscaping. This includes

his Koi fish pond which contains fish that have been with the family for nearly 40 years. Les also excelled at woodworking making furniture and creating intricate pieces of wood art known as intarsia. Les created intarsia for his home, family, friends, and for auctions to support charities and local clubs. Les was especially proud of his agility Papillon dogs, Fancy and Buddy, which have won multiple awards and champion status.
