



## Lura Ellen Schreiber

July 14, 1934 - January 25, 2026

Lura Ellen (Hendrix) Schreiber, lovingly known as “Sis,” was born on July 14, 1934, and passed away peacefully on January 25, 2026, at the age of 91.

Sis was the youngest of eleven children born to Charles Oliver Hendrix and Lura Ann (Wilson) Hendrix. She grew up in the Lobster Valley and Alsea area of Oregon, surrounded by siblings, cousins, and extended family who would know her simply as Sis for the rest of her life. She carried that name with her always — so naturally that even the staff and fellow residents at her assisted living home called her Sis.

She married Lee Roy Schreiber on September 16, 1951, and together they built a life rooted in family and hard work. They raised four sons — Mark, Bryon, Kurt, and Kyle — and shared 63 years of marriage until Lee Roy’s passing.

During the early years of their marriage, Sis devoted herself to raising four very active boys and managing the home. She also handled bookkeeping when the family operated its own log truck. Later in life, she worked for the U.S. Forest Service in Alsea, where she spent many years supporting the district’s work until her retirement.

Sis was preceded in death by her husband Lee Roy, her son Kurt, and her grandson Tyson.

Sis was the last surviving member of her immediate family, having outlived all of her brothers and sisters. With her passing, an entire chapter of family history gently closes.

She is survived by her sons and their families, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and extended family.
