Lynette M. Vail, 66 died Sunday at her home in Corvallis, OR. She was born September 26, 1946 to parents Jack and Marian Gates Chase in Bellingham, Washington. Lynette was a very accomplished musician and vocalist; at the tender age of 8, she began singing for services with her evangelist father, Jack Chase. Growing up, she participated in many church and school musical activities—band, choir and drama. During her college career, she served as vice president of the freshman class at LIFE Bible College in Los Angeles. Lynette continued to serve the Lord as an adult, teaching Sunday School, playing organ, piano or accordion for church services. She also taught the Singles Bible Study, provided child care and helped organize church fundraisers. Lynette worked as a cook, receptionist, secretary, and also as a security guard, all the while raising four children as a single parent. She is remembered by her family as a woman of remarkable strength with immeasurable God-given wisdom.

Lynette is preceded in death by her mother, Marian Chase. She is survived by her father, Jack Chase; children David (Sarah) Vail, Matt (Michelle) Vail, Robert Vail and Shela Allen; siblings Marc Chase, Jacci Nickell and Joni Chase; 10 grandchildren; 2 great grandchildren (and one on the way).

A funeral service will be held at 2:00 pm on Thursday, November 15th at Kings Circle Assembly of God Church. Pastor Brett Huff will officiate.
