Lynn Evan Farmer, a longtime resident of Philomath, passed away on Thursday, Nov. 21, 2013, at Timberview Care Center in Albany. He was 81.

Lynn was born May 29, 1932, to Oliver Farmer and Viola (Davidson) Farmer. Lynn attended Philomath schools before working in the timber industry, where he worked most of his life. He married Helen E. Carlile of Philomath on May 6, 1954, at the Corvallis Church of the Nazarene. They were married 59 years and 6 months. The couple made their home in Philomath until 1996, when they moved to Corvallis.

Lynn had many interests, including woodworking and model airplanes. He enjoyed science, animals and the outdoors. He had an ear for music and loved to sing.

He was preceded in death by his father, Oliver Farmer; his mother, Viola Farmer; his brothers, Merwin Farmer and Eden Farmer; and one infant son. He is survived by his wife, Helen Farmer; daughter, Beverly Hendrix; sons, Ronald Farmer and Donald Farmer; five grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren. He will be missed by his family.

The funeral service will take place at 1 p.m. Nov. 27 at McHenry Funeral Home in Corvallis.
