After their marriage, they moved to Philomath were they owned and operated a pump business as well as running the family farm.

Mabel enjoyed working, reading and crossword puzzles. She was a member of the Oregon Buddhist Temple, the Japanese American Citizen's League, the Oregon Nikkei Legacy Center and the Portland TAIKO. Preceded in death by her parents, her sister May Y. Shoji, brother George Shoji and sister June Shoji; Mabel is survived by her husband of 64 years, Monte Boggs.
