



Marcile Yastrop

April 19, 1917 - September 4, 2010

Marcile Lottie Yastrop, 93, mother, grandmother and great-grandmother, died Sept. 4 at the Mennonite Home in Albany.

Marcile was born as Marcile Lottie Welch on April 19, 1917, in Haddam, Kan. Marcile was the second-youngest of seven children. She grew up in Kansas with a large family. When she was a young child, her father passed away in 1921, and her mother remarried in 1923, adding another six children to her family.

In 1945, Marcile met Carl Yastrop in Nebraska, where he served in the military, and nine months later, they were married. She raised her four children in Blackfoot, Idaho, before moving to Corvallis in 1965.

Marcile is survived by her children, Mark Yastrop of Tucson, Ariz., Mary Ann Bates of Albany, Kent Yastrop of Albany, and John Yastrop of Philomath; her stepsisters, Neva of Corvallis, and Dorothy and Vearl of Kansas; and many grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Carl Yastrop; four sisters; and five brothers.
