



## Marian Vendetti

August 14, 1916 - August 6, 2007

Marian Martha Vendetti, 90 died Monday at Conifer House in Corvallis. Born August 14th, 1916 in Ironwood, Michigan, she was the daughter of Joseph and Martha Kubacki. She graduated from Keewatin High School in Keewatin, Minnesota in 1934 and married Albert Vendetti on June 3, 1937. They have two children, Corinne and Allan.
