On July 17, 2017, Marsha Lenore Bianconi quietly passed away at the age of 75.

Marsha was born January 8, 1942 in West Covina, California to Harold and Maria Impink. She grew up and spent her early years in the Los Angeles area, later moving to Sacramento where she was employed by the State of California.

In retirement, Marsha dreamed of moving to Oregon; she relocated to Corvallis in 2006.

Marsha touched many lives through her volunteer work. In Sacramento, she worked at a shelter for abused women. In Corvallis, she gave many hours to Volunteer Interfaith Caregivers and to the Episcopal Church of the Good Samaritan where she helped in the office and founded a knitting group.

Marsha loved to knit. Over the years, she created special garments for family and friends as well as prayer shawls and caps for schoolchildren.

Marsha had a lively and engaging presence along with an irrepressible sense of humor.

Marsha raised two daughters, Marisa Bianconi, of Sacramento, California and Julie O'Malley of Alturas, California, both of whom survive her. Additional survivors include her life partner Karen Stevens of Corvallis; brother, Donald Impink of Austin, Texas; and sister Celeste Koontz of Highlands Ranch, Colorado. She also leaves behind five grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Her passing is an enormous loss to all who knew her.
