



Mary Marguerite O'Brien

January 26, 1919 - August 5, 2013

Marguerite O'Brien, 94, died at P.S. We Love Seniors in Corvallis. Marguerite was born in Centralia, Washington, to Ruby and Jacob Pittman; the oldest daughter and second child of four.

She married John O'Brien on November 6, 1939, in Midland, Washington. They moved to Oregon in 1944 living in Cottage Grove, Waldport, Toledo, and Alsea. Marguerite was a homemaker, mother of six, grandmother of 14, and great grandmother of 27. Marguerite was an Elder of the Cowlitz Indian Tribe.

She enjoyed crocheting and donated several afghans to the fund raising efforts of the Alsea Clinic, as well as keeping family and friends supplied with dish cloths and potholders.

Marguerite was preceded in death by her husband, John; brother, Hubert Pittman; sister, Eileen Goodwin; son, Michael O'Brien; daughter, Rose Mary O'Brien-Loucks; a grandson; and a great granddaughter.

Survivors include her sister, Frances McMahan (Norman); two sons, John O'Brien (Linda) of Randle, Washington and Steven O'Brien (Mary) of Alsea, Oregon; two daughters, Kathleen Petrucela of Corvallis, Oregon and Margaret Mulder (Bill) of Toledo, Oregon; daughter-in-law, Patrice O'Brien of Corvallis; 13 grandchildren and 26 great grandchildren.
