M. Regina (Deschamps) Anderson-Runnion of Corvallis, formerly Eugene, passed away the morning of Thursday, Jan. 19, at Timberhill Place.

She was born April 8, 1941, and hailed from Missoula, Montana. Some of her life's accomplishments included being elected attorney general of the 1958 Oregon Girl's State, while representing St. Francis High School of Eugene. Regina was chosen for the national honor society, was president of the ski club, and belonged to the pep and glee clubs. She went on to formal studies and nurse training at OHSU in Portland and became a nurse to the University of Oregon football team, and at Good Samaritan hospital in Corvallis.

Regina had four children with Ted E. Anderson: Brett, Bruce, Marcie and Bart. She married Andrew Runnion, Oct. 13, 2001.

Regina will be remembered for her dedication to her Catholic faith, attending mass on a regular basis at St. Mary's in Corvallis, her passion for gardening, her spunk and love for travel, and her helpful, kind and thoughtful nature towards everyone she came in contact with.

Regina is survived by her younger brother, Danny Deschamps of Eugene; and her children, Bruce, Marcie and Bart.

A formal funeral will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 26 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Corvallis.
