Mary A. Williams, 88 of Cascadia died Saturday at Samaritan Lebanon Community Hospital. Born September 26, 1919 in Klondike, Oregon; she was the daughter of Edward and Louise Thomas. Mary spent her entire working career as a Registered Nurse—first as an OB nurse at Columbia Hospital in Astoria and later at Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center.
