Myrna was born on December 4, 1942 in Valentine, Nebraska to Elvira and Jesse Main. She was the third youngest of fourteen children. She started high school and married Lee Stoneman of Weiser in December of 1958 when she was a sophomore.

Myrna and Lee welcomed twin daughters, Dina and Dena, and later a son, Dennis. Myrna was a homemaker until Lee had an accident and it required her to start a career. She went back to school and got her GED. Myrna and Lee later divorced.

In 1987, Myrna married Don Shaw and became stepmother to his four children. Interestingly, one of Don's sons was also named Dennis! Don passed away in 2001.

Myrna worked in Seaside, Oregon as a bartender and later as a cashier; first at Sprouse Reitz and then at Safeway. She worked her way up to deli manager until retirement in 2004.

In 2007, Myrna decided she wanted a new car and she returned to work, this

time at Bi-Mart, and soon purchased a white VW Beetle convertible which was a real joy in her life. She retired for good in 2010.

Myrna held several offices in the Lincoln City Eagle Lodge. An Alaskan cruise was taken with a best friend. Her daughter, Dina said, "There was not a single person who walked through her door that she didn't make feel welcome. She was a valued friend."

Myrna battled cancer for some time which metastasized and eventually spread throughout her body. Through January 2021 she was able to care for herself. But when she fell and could no longer walk on her own, Dina moved into her home and cared for her until her passing on March 8, 2021.

A Memorial service and celebration of life for Myrna will be held the last week of June 2021 with inurnment in Orofino.
