



Norman Carl Edwards

July 21, 1921 - December 29, 2013

Norman Carl Edwards, a lifelong resident of Eddyville, passed away Sunday, Dec. 29, 2013. He was 92.

Norman was born July 21, 1921, in Newberg, the son of Carl D. and Catherine (Hall) Edwards.

He graduated from Eddyville High School. He married Lois Marie Dunn on May 29, 1943, in Spokane, Wash., while stationed at Geiger Field.

Norman served in the U.S. Army during World War II, from 1943 to 1945. He landed on Normandy Beach three days after

D-Day, and fought through France, Belgium and Germany.

Norman enjoyed farming, and his favorite pastime was fishing. He especially enjoyed fishing at the Ana Reservoir in Central Oregon. He made his own lures and tied his own flies.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife of 59 years; and four sisters.

Survivors include four daughters, Sharon (Bob) Parrish of Illinois, Joyce

(John) Pfeifer of California, Yolonda (Dennis) Castle of Falls City and Rhonda (Don) Miller of Monmouth; one son, Tom (Lori) Edwards of Ontario; 11 grandchildren; 16 great-grandchildren; and two sisters.

Visitation is set for 10 a.m. Saturday, Jan. 4, just prior to funeral services at 11 a.m., both at McHenry Funeral Home in Corvallis. Interment will take place in Eddyville Cemetery.
