April 28, 1924 - October 7, 2016

Patricia Hunter Noble of Philomath, 92, died in her home on October 7. She was born the youngest of four children in Arcata, California on April 28, 1924 to Kathryn Fielding Hunter and James E. Hunter. Patricia was married to Junior Lee Noble on June 11, 1955. In 1963 they moved to Philomath where they purchased the "Lone Star" ranch, named by Patricia's father James, as she was the "lone Lady/star" amongst those moving to Oregon.
